Why Suboxone?

When you need help now!

Opiate addiction has reached epidemic proportions in Ohio and in our community. People are suffering, some are dying and families are struggling. Lack of accessible services specific to opiate addiction is a barrier to making recovery possible.

Philosophy:

Opiate addiction is a disease that is chronic, progressive and often fatal. Suboxone is a treatment method for long-term opiate addiction. Use of this medication along with comprehensive treatment services allows individuals to function normally without intoxication, impairment or fear of withdrawal symptoms. Suboxone treatment is provided in combination with a full array of outpatient or residential services. Treatment is collaborative and individualized. Family or other support person involvement is essential.

Goal:

The goal of treatment is to reach and maintain the best possible level of functioning while working toward a drug- and alcohol-free lifestyle.

Residential Services:

Residential services are available for those who need a higher level of care, or for whom outpatient services have not been successful.

Bridgeview Manor, is a 16 bed Dual Diagnosis facility providing services to adult males 21 years old or older with Medicaid. They are open to residents of any county in Ohio. For more information on residential services contact:

Admission Criteria:

- Must be 18 years or older
- Diagnosed opiate dependent
- Has established residence (outpatient services)
- Willing to participate in all treatment services
- Live within 50 miles of facility
- Is not allergic to Suboxone
- Medically stable
- Stable on psychiatric medication
- Ohio Medicaid

Suboxone Treatment Process:

Week	1	Evaluation
Week	2	Induction
Week	3 - 16	Stabilization
Month	4 - 12	Maintenance
